FASTag Services Migration from account-based solution to Wallet based toll payment solution effective after 15.02.2026

Central Bank of India is migrating its FASTag services from account-based solution to wallet-based toll payment solution. Customers are requested to recharge their FASTag wallet using UPI VPA in format netc.<Vehicle Registration Number>@cbin through any UPI app.

e.g. netc.mh00bb11@cbin

The Vehicle Registration Number should be in small letters. After recharge customer may login to the Cent eeZ application and access the FASTag portal using following navigation:

Login to Cent eeZ >>Dashboard Page >> Scroll right in Payments >> Manage FASTag

Customer may also login to website <https://fastag.centralbank.bank.in/fleetui> using their mobile number and view the updated balance. More payment option to recharge the wallet shall be introduced in coming days.

FASTag portal is having the features viz Wallet balance, Monthly top-up, Toll transactions and Vehicle details, Statements etc.

The wallet-based FASTag model will be effective after 15.02.2026. Till 15.02.2026 Toll charges recovery will be continued through existing linked account. Customers are requested to recharge their wallet before 15.02.2026 to continue availing the seamless FASTag services.

The existing hold amount will be released and credited to customer's account. The negative balance shown in Wallet shall be adjusted against the recovered toll amount.

The updated Wallet balance after 15.02.2026 will be as following:

Balance in Wallet= Total Recharge Amount-Unrecovered toll amount (if any)
