90-day work threshold for gig workers' security may be eased

New Delhi, January 16

THE GOVERNMENT IS likely to reduce or potentially remove the proposed minimum annual work threshold for gig workers to avail social security benefits under the Social Security Code, 2020, official sources said.

A set of draft rules under the Code released recently proposed a 90-day minimum work with a single aggregator, or 120 days across multiple platforms, in a financial year as eligibility criteria for these workers' social security benefits.

"We have received feedback that over 70% of gig workers will be left out of social security benefits due to this minimum threshold. We would reduce the threshold or remove it, if needed," an official source said. The draft rules require that gig workers must be engaged for at least 90 days with a sin-

gle aggregator, or 120 days across multiple platforms, in a financial year, to qualify for social security benefits, including health, life, and personal accident insurance.

The government has invited feedback on the draft rules for 45 days. Earlier, FE reported that labour unions and worker groups

had warned that if the draft rules are adopted in its current form risk, it would rendering most gig workers ineligible for social security benefits by setting participation thresholds far higher than actual work patterns in the sector.

The rules do allow double-counting when workers are active on multiple platforms simultaneously.

For instance, someone working on Zomato and Swiggy on the same day would accrue two days toward the threshold. But union leaders have told FE

that even this flexibility won't help most workers qualify.

Worker groups cited data shared by Eternal CEO Deepinder Goyal through a post on X, as evidence that the majority would miss this threshold. Goyal's post had claimed that the average delivery partner on its platforms worked just 38 days and 7 hour per working day in 2025, with only 2.3% working more than 250 days annually.

Unions argue that even by accounting for workers juggling multiple platforms simultaneously, most would struggle to meet the 120-day threshold.

The unions have been demanding social security that is universal, portable, and pro-rata, beginning from the first day of work, with clear, enforceable contribution norms across platforms.

A 2022 Niti Aayog report estimated 7.7 million gig and platform workers in 2020-21, projected to reach 23.5 million by 2029-30.

The Ministry of Labour and Employment has invited feedback for 45 days before finalising the rules.

Metro rail expansion eases home loan stress: EAC-PM

INDIA'S RAPID METRO rail expansion is delivering benefits far beyond faster commutes and cleaner air. A new working paper by the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister (EAC-PM) found that improved metro connectivity has significantly reduced home-loan delinquency and increased prepayments in major cities, strengthening household balance sheets and contributing to broader financial stability.

Using granular, loan-level data, the study examined how metro rail expansion has shaped household financial behaviour in Hyderabad, Bengaluru, and Delhi.

The findings point to a clear and economically meaningful trend: households living in metro-connected neighbourhoods are better able to service their mortgages, largely due to lower transportation costs and reduced dependence on private vehicles. Delhi showed the most pronounced improvement, with mortgage delinquency declining by 4.42% alongside a 1.38% increase in prepayments. The impact was also stronger in Bengaluru, where delinquency fell by 2.4% and prepayments increased by 3.5%. In Hyderabad, borrowers residing in metro-served PIN



codes recorded a 1.7% decline in delinquency incidence and a 1.8% rise in prepayment activity after metro connectivity was introduced.

The underlying mechanism, the paper authored by Soumya Kanti Ghosh, Pulak Ghosh and Falguni Sinha argued, is straightforward. Reliable and efficient public transport reduced the need for households to own and operate private vehicles—one of the largest recurring non-housing expenses for urban families. Lower fuel, maintenance and financing costs free up monthly cash flows, easing the burden of equated monthly instalments (EMIs) on housing loans. Supporting this channel, vehicle registration data from metro-served cities show a marked decline in registrations of two-

wheelers and light motor vehicles, particularly among middle- and lower-middle-income households.

The findings come against the backdrop of India's unprecedented metro build-out over the past decade. The country's operational metro network has expanded from 248 km across five cities in 2014 to over 1,025 km across 20 cities by October 2025, with nearly 650 km currently under construction. Average daily ridership has surged from 28 lakh in 2013-14 to more than 1.12 crore, underscoring a structural shift in urban mobility. India is now the world's third-largest metro network, a transformation aligned with the PM GatiShakti National Master Plan's push for integrated, multimodal infrastructure.

Virat Kohli, Anushka Sharma buy land in Alibaug

CRICKETER VIRAT KOHLI and his wife Anushka Sharma have bought 1.36 hectare land at Alibag near Mumbai for ₹37.86 crore, according to CRE Matrix.

Real estate data analytic firm CRE Matrix, which has reviewed the property registration document, said that the former Indian cricket captain Virat Kohli and actor Anushka Sharma have bought two land parcels totalling 21,010 sq metres at Alibag, Raigad. The registration was done on January 13, 2026. The size of the first plot is 14,740 square metres, while the size of the second plot is 6,270 square metres. The total deal value is ₹37.86 crore and around ₹2.27 crore was paid towards stamp duty. As per the CRE Matrix, the seller is Sonali Amit Rajput. Samira Land Assets is the confirming party. Post-Covid pandemic, there has been a surge in real estate transactions by film stars, cricketers, big corporates and other ultra high net worth individuals in the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR). Neither Kohli nor Sharma could be contacted for comments. FE BUREAU

ICRA estimates gross tax revenue growth at 7% in FY27

RATING AGENCY ICRA has projected gross tax revenues to grow by around 7% in FY27, led by a robust 11% expansion in direct taxes.

This will provide critical support for fiscal consolidation, despite muted growth in indirect taxes following GST rate cuts implemented from September 2025.

Against this backdrop, ICRA expects the fiscal deficit to be capped at 4.3% of GDP in FY2027, marginally lower than the Budget Estimate of 4.4% in FY2026, assuming nominal GDP growth of 9.8%.

The FY2027 Budget is likely to signal a structural shift toward a medium-term debt reduction path, aligned with the forthcoming recommendations of the 16th Finance Commission, it said in a pre-Budget note.



Central government debt is estimated to decline to 55.1% of GDP in FY2027 from 56.1% in FY2026. Achieving the medium-term target of 50% (±1%) by FY2031 would require an average reduction of about one percentage point in FY2026, assuming nominal GDP growth of 9.8%.

On the expenditure side, capital expenditure is expected to rise by around 14% to ₹13.1 lakh crore in FY2027, equivalent to 3.3% of GDP.

This acceleration is likely to occur before fiscal rigidities

increase from FY2028 onward, driven by higher salary and pension commitments following the 8th Central Pay Commission. In contrast, revenue expenditure growth is expected to remain modest at around 4%, aided by slower growth in interest payments and a moderation in subsidy outgo.

Consequently, the revenue deficit is projected to decline to ₹4.7 lakh crore, or 1.2% of GDP, in FY2027.

On the financing front, gross market borrowings are expected to rise to ₹16.9 lakh crore, largely reflecting higher redemptions, while net market issuances may increase to ₹12.2 lakh crore.

Overall, supported by stable growth assumptions and improving revenue quality, FY2027 is expected to mark a calibrated step toward fiscal and debt consolidation, it added.

AI crash probe: Why pilot grouping FIP sent a legal notice to AAIB over summoning captain's nephew

PILOT GROUPING FEDERATION of Indian Pilots (FIP) recently served a legal notice to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB) after the probe agency asked the nephew of Sumet Sabharwal — one of the pilots of the ill-fated Air India Boeing 787-8 aircraft that crashed in Ahmedabad on June 12 — to appear before it.

The FIP has been critical of the AAIB's ongoing investigation, even terming it "untenable", and had demanded that the Centre initiate a judicial investigation into the crash, instead of relying on AAIB.

Along with the late pilot's father Pushkar Raj Sabharwal, the FIP had also filed a writ petition in the Supreme Court, challenging the fairness of the AAIB probe. With Sabharwal's nephew Varun Anand, who is



also a pilot with Air India, being asked to appear before the AAIB as part of the investigation, the FIP has once again questioned the AAIB probe and alleged that summoning Anand, who is neither a factual,

technical, or expert witness, raises the apprehension that the investigation is "proceeding on a preconceived narrative" of blaming Sabharwal for the fatal crash. On its part, the AAIB said that the Aircraft

(Investigation of Accidents and Incidents) Rules 2025 empower the investigators "to call and examine any witness relevant to the investigation". While the legal notice sent on behalf of FIP claimed that the summoning of Anand is "wholly unwarranted" and amounts to "harassment and distress", it said that Anand will appear before the investigators via video conference to answer their queries.

On behalf of the FIP, law firm APJ-SLG Law Offices sent a legal notice to the AAIB over the summoning of Anand in relation to the AI 171 crash investigation. According to the FIP, since Anand does not operate the Boeing 787 — the aircraft type of the plane crashed in Ahmedabad — and had no association with the doomed flight's "planning, dispatch, operation, maintenance, certification, airworthiness clearance or crew composition",

which raises questions on his summoning. "He (Anand) was not present at the site of the accident and does not possess any factual, technical or operational knowledge relating to the circumstances of the said accident. The summoning of the nephew of the deceased pilot and his relatives, irrespective of their lack of nexus with the incident, reinforces the apprehension that such actions are not rooted in any lawful investigative necessity," the notice said, adding that asking Anand to appear was contrary to aircraft accident investigation rules, "which strictly confine accident investigations to technical, safety-oriented fact-finding and expressly prohibit attribution of blame or liability".

"Capt. Varun Anand is neither a factual witness nor a technical witness nor an expert witness in relation to the said accident," it said.

Key winners & losers in BMC

Former mayor Pednekar among key winners; Gawli daughters among losers

THE LONG-AWAITED polls to elect a body of representatives to the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation threw up many surprises as several heavyweights and experienced people of the erstwhile civic house took a drubbing on Friday.

In a big defeat for the Akhil Bhartiya Sena (ABS), founded by 'Daddy' Arun Gawli, his daughters Yogita Gawli and Geeta Gawli were defeated in ward numbers 207 and 212 respectively. While Geeta Gawli was the sitting corporator and the only ABS representative from 212, Samajwadi Party's Amreen Shehzan Abrahni managed to wrest the seat from her by a significant margin of over 2,000 votes as per the initial trends. Her sister Yogita Gawli, who also fought on an ABS ticket, was beaten by BJP's Madhukar Rohidas Lokhande.

Their defeat is indicative of the waning influence of the ABS in ward 212 which was viewed as the party's stronghold in the past three terms.

First elected as a corporator in 1992 and re-elected to power for five terms since, former Leader of Opposition of BMC, Ravi Raja, was also defeated on Friday by the sitting corporator of ward number 185, Sena (UBT)'s T.M. Jagdish. While Ravi Raja had previously won as a Congress leader, in 2024, he switched to the BJP after he was denied an Assembly ticket. Meanwhile, this also marked the first election outside his home turf of ward 176 of Sion.

In the eastern suburbs, Kaptaan Malik of NCP, the sitting corporator from ward 170 since 2022, who fought from ward 165, was defeated by Ashraf Azmi, the Congress heavyweight who managed to retain his seat by a comfortable margin on Friday. The brother of former minister Nawab Malik, Kaptaan Malik was forced to contest outside his home turf of ward 170 owing to a change in

reservation in what made the contest in ward number 165 a closely watched one.

In ward 194, a Shiv Sena bastion, Shiv Sena's (Shinde) Samadhan Sada Sarvankar, son of politician Sada Sarvankar, was defeated by Sena UBT's Nishikant Shinde by a margin of over 600 votes.

Big winners

Despite upsets, many familiar faces of BMC's former general body managed to retain their political turfs on Friday.

In the Sena stronghold of ward 199 in Parel, UBT candidate Kishori Pednekar, last sitting mayor of Mumbai, won in a battle against the Shiv Sena (Shinde) candidate Rupal Rajesh Kusale by a margin of 1,680 votes.


In ward 191, which encompasses Shivaji Park among other planned neighbourhoods of Dadar, former mayor of BMC house-Vishakha Raut-also won against the Shinde-Sena led candidate.

Tejasvee Ghosalkar, former Shiv Sena (UBT) corporator who contested as a BJP candidate, also emerged winner with a landslide margin of over 10,755 votes against Dhanashree Kolge, who was fielded by Sena UBT in ward number 2 of Dahisar.

Tejasvee is the daughter-in-law of Sena (UBT) stalwart and former MLA Vinod Ghosalkar, whose husband, Abhishek, the elder son of Vinod and a former corporator from ward 1, was shot dead in February 2024 by local political aspirant Mouris Noronha during a Facebook live stream.

Another former mayor, Milind Vaidya, who served between 1996 and 1997, also won and managed to retain his seat of ward number 182 on a Sena (UBT) ticket.

Pooja Mahadeshwar, wife of former mayor, Vishwanath Mahadeshwar also managed to win by a margin of 2,400 votes. She managed to retain the ward, 87, on a UBT ticket, where her husband had served as the councillor between 2017 and 2022.

BJP sweeps MMR but Vasai Virar remains with Thakurs

AT A time when the BJP has tightened its grip over most urban centres in the Mumbai Metropolitan Region, Vasai Virar has emerged as a rare exception, with the family of Hitendra Thakur founded—Bahujan Vikas Aghadi—retaining control of the civic body.

The Bahujan Vikas Aghadi won 71 of the 115 seats in the Vasai-Virar City Municipal Corporation, comfortably crossing the majority mark and keeping the BJP out of power. While the party's seat share has dropped sharply from the 106 seats it had won in 2015, the Thakur family has managed to keep its hold on the city.

The BJP, however, has made significant gains. From winning just one seat in 2015, the party has expanded its presence to 43 seats this time, marking its strongest showing ever in Vasai Virar. Despite this surge, it fell short of dislodging the Bahujan Vikas Aghadi from power. The Eknath Shinde led Shiv Sena managed to win one seat, while the Congress and the Uddhav Thackeray led Shiv Sena failed to open their accounts.

The verdict is politically significant beyond the numbers. As the BJP has steadily expanded across the Mumbai Metropolitan Region, Vasai Virar stands out as the only major municipal corporation where the party has been unable to wrest control, highlighting the resilience of Hitendra Thakur's local organisation.

The election carried high

stakes for the Thakur family. In the recent Assembly elections, both Hitendra and his son Kshitij Thakur had suffered defeats, raising questions about whether the Bahujan Vikas Aghadi's influence in the region was finally waning. The civic polls, held after a gap of nearly a decade, were therefore widely seen as a test of Thakur's political standing.

The BJP had done well in Assembly elections with victories in Vasai and Nalasopara and a series of defections from the Bahujan Vikas Aghadi. Several senior party leaders of the BVA crossed over to the BJP ahead of the Municipal Corporation polls. Hitendra Thakur, a former six time MLA from Vasai, has long been a dominant figure in the semi urban belt of Vasai, Virar and Nalasopara in Palghar district. The Thakur family's influence extends beyond politics, with deep roots in local businesses.

In the run up to the 2024 Assembly elections, relations between the Thakurs and the BJP deteriorated sharply. A major controversy erupted when BJP national general secretary Vinod Tawde was allegedly caught with cash at a hotel in Virar East more than 17 hours after the end of the Assembly campaign. The incident was reportedly exposed by supporters of the Thakur family and caused considerable embarrassment to the BJP.

However, the Thakurs themselves suffered a major setback soon after, failing to win a single Assembly seat. Over the past year, the Bahujan Vikas Aghadi also witnessed a wave of defections, alongside sustained efforts by the BJP to make inroads into the region.

While the BJP has succeeded in building a strong base of over 40 corporators in Vasai Virar, it has stopped short of ending the Thakur family's long standing control over the municipal corporation.

52.9% turnout in Mumbai; second-highest in 32 years

MUMBAI RECORDED an overall voter turnout of 52.94 per cent in the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) election held on Thursday — the second highest the city has seen in the last 32 years.

According to the civic body's data, the highest turnout was 55.28 per cent, reported in 2017, before which it was 49.14 per cent, as recorded in the 1992 polls.

The current poll has been held after a gap of nine years, which includes a four-year delay since the tenure of the last elected body expired.

While most wards recorded a voter turnout of over 50 per cent on Thursday, three wards saw the figures crossing 60 per cent. The highest voting turnout was recorded in the western suburbs of Borivali and Dahisar, while the lowest was at Kalbadevi, Pydhonie and the Bhuleshwar area in South Mumbai.

The data shows that a turnout of 62.04 per cent was recorded in Ward 18 in Borivali which is witnessing a direct fight between Shiv Sena's Sandhya Vipul Doshi and Sadichha More of the Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS).

This is followed by a 60.67 per cent turnout recorded at Ward 4 in Dahisar where a

three-cornered contest is underway between Sena's Mangesh Pangare, Sena (UBT) candidate Raju Mulla and Congress's Rahul Vishwakarma.

Ward 9 in Borivali recorded a turnout of 60.5 per cent. Nine candidates are in the fray here, including the BJP's Shivanand Shetty, Sanjay Bhosale from the Sena (UBT), and Sadanand Chauhan from the Congress.

Meanwhile, the lowest turnout of 38.21 per cent has been recorded at Ward 222 in the Kalbadevi area of South Mumbai. Here, six candidates from the BJP, Sena (UBT), Congress, Samajwadi Party (SP), and the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) are contesting the elections.

Mahayuti surge: Mumbai mayor will be ours, says Shinde

AS THE Mahayuti gained upper hand in Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation polls by winning over 110 seat by Friday night, Deputy Chief Minister Eknath Shinde on Friday said

that the Shiv Sena-BJP Mahayuti has reached the threshold of a majority in the civic body elections across Maharashtra, and Mahayuti mayors will be elected in several municipal corporations.

Addressing a press conference in Thane, Shinde said the

alliance has made strong gains in Thane, Kalyan-Dombivli, the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR), and Mumbai. He stated that Shiv Sena has secured a clear majority in Thane, while the Mahayuti has also registered a strong performance across the MMR region.

Expressing confidence over Mumbai, Shinde said the Shiv Sena-BJP alliance would rule the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation. "We are very close to a majority. In many municipal corporations across the state, the Mahayuti will form the government," he said.

Shinde said that during the campaign, emotional issues, allegations of corruption, and various narratives were pushed by opponents.

However, voters in Mumbai and across Maharashtra chose development over emotional appeals, he said.

Shiv Sena (UBT) wins 6 out of 7 seats in its bastion Worli

IN THE high-stakes BMC polls, the Shiv Sena (UBT) won six of the seven corporator seats in Worli — regarded as the bastion of the undivided Shiv Sena and the legislative constituency of Shiv Sena UBT leader Aaditya Thackeray. The election witnessed a direct face-off between the two rival Sena factions in five of the seven wards.

The remaining one seat was won by the Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena.

Worli has historically been a stronghold of the undivided Shiv Sena, dominated by traditional Marathi voters from middle- and lower-middle-class backgrounds, many of them former mill workers who later formed the party's core cadre base.

Across legislative and civic elections, Worli has consistently remained a safe Sena seat. Since 2014, two Mumbai mayors and one deputy mayor have been elected from this constituency.

Election data shows that Shiv Sena (UBT) has retained all but one seat in Worli in this election cycle. The sole seat won by the Shinde faction came in a multi-cornered contest, defeating candidates from the Maharashtra Navnirman Party (MNS) and the Nationalist Congress Party (NCP).

The Worli civic constituency comprises seven corporator wards (193 to 199). Between 2017 and 2022, all seven were held by the undivided Sena. Following the party split, three sitting corporators joined the Shinde faction.

वसईत बविआची तिसऱ्यांदा सरशी

मिरा भाईंदर महापालिकेत भाजपचे वर्चस्व कायम

वसई : महापालिका निवडणुकीत वसई-विसारमध्ये बहुजन विकास आघाडीने तिसऱ्यांदा विजय मिळवला, तर मिरा भाईंदरमध्ये शिवसेनेचा (शिंदे गट) दारुण पराभव करत भाजपने पुन्हा एकदा वर्चस्व सिद्ध केले.

पालघर जिल्ह्यातील एकमेव वसई विरार महापालिकेत २००९ पासून हितेंद्र ठाकूर यांच्या बहुजन विकास आघाडी पक्षाची सत्ता आहे. पण, २०२४ साली पार पडलेल्या लोकसभा-विधानसभा निवडणुकीनंतर शहरातील राजकीय समीकरणे बदलली. लोकसभा निवडणुकीत भाजपचे डॉ. हेमंत सावरा यांनी बहुजन विकास आघाडीच्या राजेश पाटील यांचा पराभव केला. त्याच वर्षी विधानसभा निवडणुकीत भाजपचा स्नेहा दुबे पंडीत आणि राजन नाईक यांनी बविआचे हितेंद्र ठाकूर आणि शिंदे गट यांचा पराभव करत ३५ वर्षांच्या सत्तेला सुरुंग लावला. महापालिका निवडणुकीत मात्र



बहुजन विकास आघाडीने ११५ पैकी ७० जागा जिंकत तिसऱ्यांदा वर्चस्व सिद्ध केले आहे. तर दुसरीकडे २०१५ च्या तुलनेत ४३ जागांची सरशी घेत भाजपनेही विरोधक म्हणून आपले स्थान निश्चित केले आहे.

वसई विरारप्रमाणे मिरा भाईंदर महापालिका निवडणुकीत चर्चेत राहिली. ठाणे जिल्ह्याचा भाग असलेले आणि मुंबई व पालघरच्या वेशीवर वसलेले मिरा भाईंदर शहर हे २०१४ पासून भाजपचा गड म्हणून ओळखले जाते. यापूर्वी या महापालिकेत भाजपने एकहाती सत्ताही गाजवली आहे. पण,

महापालिका क्षेत्राचा भाग असणाऱ्या ओवळा माजिवडा मतदार संघातून चारवेळा निवडून आलेले आमदार व परिवहन मंत्री प्रताप सरनाईक आणि मिरा भाईंदरचे आमदार नरेंद्र मेहता यांच्यात जागावाटपावरून झालेल्या वादांमुळे महापालिका निवडणुका काळात महायुतीतील या दोन्ही पक्षांमध्ये संघर्ष निर्माण झाला. त्यामुळे शिवसेना (शिंदे गट) नेते प्रताप सरनाईक यांनी भाजपला आव्हान देत ८७ पैकी ८१ प्रभागांत उमेदवार उभे केले. भाजपनेही ८७ प्रभागांत उमेदवार रिंगणात उतरवले. यात भाजपने मुसंडी घेत

७५ जागांवर विजय मिळवला. सत्ता स्थापनेच्या घोषणा करणाऱ्या सरनाईकांना मात्र ३ जागांवर समाधान मानावे लागले.

समितीचे अध्यक्ष किंवा अन्य महत्त्वाचे पद पदरात पाडून घेतील, अशी शक्यता व्यक्त होत आहे.

शिंदे यांच्या ठाणे या बालेकिल्ल्यात ७५ जागा मिळाल्या. शिंदे गटाचे हे सर्वाधिक यश आहे. कल्याण-डोंबिवलीत ५४, नवी मुंबई ४२, उल्हासनगर ३६, नाशिक २६, जळगाव २२ हे अपवाद वगळता अन्य महानगरपालिकांमध्ये शिंदे गटाला फार मोठे यश मिळालेले नाही. लातूर आणि परभणीमध्ये शिंदे गटाला भोपळी फोडता आलेला नाही. शिवसेना शिंदे गटाला राज्यातील २९ महानगरपालिकांमध्ये एकूण ३९४ जागा मिळाल्या आहेत. विधानसभेत शिंदे गटाचे ५७ आमदार निवडून आले आहेत. गेल्या मसिन्यात झालेल्या नगरपालिका निवडणुकीतही शिंदे

गटाचे ३७ नगराध्यक्ष निवडून आले होते. या तुलनेत महानगरपालिकेत मात्र शिंदे गटाची कामगिरी निराशाजनक झाल्याचे समोर आले आहे.

(पान १ वरून) निवडणुकीचे सर्वाधिकार मुख्यमंत्री देवेंद्र फडणवीस यांनी नाईक यांच्याकडे दिले. याठिकाणी झालेल्या रंगतदार लढतीत भाजपने ६५ जागा मिळवत एकहाती सत्ता मिळवली आहे. मीरा-भाईंदरमध्ये भाजपचे आमदार नरेंद्र मेहता यांच्याविरोधात परिवहनमंत्री प्रताप सरनाईक यांनी शड्डू ठोकला होता. तेथेही शिंदेसेनेला दारुण पराभवाचे तोंड पाहावे लागले. उल्हासनगरात शिंदे यांनी पणू कलानी यांचा मुलगा ओमी यांच्याबरोबर हातमिळवणी करत निवडणूक लढवली होती. तेथे भाजपने ओमी आणि शिंदे यांच्या पक्षाला शह देत समसमान जागा मिळवले आहे.

ठाण्यात सात वर्षांपूर्वी झालेल्या महापालिका निवडणुकीत शिवसेनेने एकहाती सत्ता मिळवली होती. यलग दान वेळा शिंदे यांनी ठाण्यात एकहाती सत्तेच्या दिशेने कूच केली आहे.
