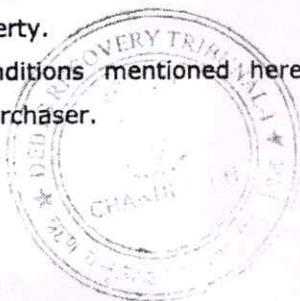
1. The property shall be sold "**AS IS WHERE IS BASIS**" and "**WHAT IS WHERE IS BASIS**" shall be subject to other terms and conditions as published on the official website of the e-auction agency.
2. All the payments shall be made through by way of DD/Pay order/Bankers Cheque in favour of **Recovery Officer-I, (DRT-I) Chandigarh, a/c RC/37/2020** as given in the sale notice.
3. Any person, unless disqualified, may submit bid which shall be accompanied by the earnest money not less than 10% the reserve price or as prescribed in auction sale notice as decided by the Recovery Officer and uploaded on the website.
